We know that hardworking Nevadans should be able to get good-paying jobs that can support a family, send their kids to good schools, have access to quality healthcare, and secure a stable retirement.

Jobs of the Future

Diversifying Nevada's economy and making our state an easier place to bring, start, or grow a business.

- [AB405 introduced by Assemblyman Chris Brooks](#), who has championed several measures designed to return Nevada to the status as the leading state when it comes to renewable energy development, creates the Solar Bill of Rights which establishes protections for customers installing solar panels and other renewable energy systems. We are committed to increasing the use of renewable energy, but we recognize that we must protect consumers so that those who want to participate in clean energy expansion are not taken advantage of by any bad actors who may emerge.

Government Accountability

Increasing accessibility of services and making it easier for Nevadans to hold their government accountable.

- [AB272 introduced by Speaker Jason Frierson](#) seeks to make voting easy for everyone in our community. It authorizes county clerks to create multiple locations where you can vote on election day, extends early voting to include the weekend before election day, allows ballots to be printed in Mandarin and Cantonese, and allows polling places to be located on Indian reservations and colonies. We are excited to have moved AB272 out of the Assembly in a bipartisan way and look forward to its consideration in the Senate.

Supporting Family Values

Supporting family values means treating our families with decency and fairness.

- [AB288 introduced by Assemblywoman Amber Joiner](#) increases penalties for those who engage in elder abuse so that our most vulnerable citizens enjoy the protections they have earned and deserve. This bill was also voted out of the Assembly with both Democratic and

Republican support, and we are enthusiastic about its consideration in the Senate.

Security for our Families

Nevada families should always feel safe and secure in their homes, community, and state.

- [**AB297 introduced by Assemblywoman Sandra Jauregui**](#) provides a safe alternative for people to meet up to complete internet exchanges and lessen the chance of being victimized in less secure locations. AB297 would designate “e-commerce exchange zones” at police stations in our communities for people to have the option of safely meeting and completing internet sales.

With 30 days left in the 2017 Legislative Session, our goal is to continue to champion legislation that will empower Nevada’s hardworking families!
